Based in Cape Town, the station has transformed into a truly multimedia content curator that serves a discerning talk audience. The format allows us to unravel the complex and delve deep into current issues to help audiences make sense of their world.

With more than 143 000 terrestrial listeners, CapeTalk connects audiences to the real conversations in their community, their city and beyond. 75% of our audience is SEM 9 and 10.

A line-up of heavy-weight presenters call the station home, including John Maytham and Refilwe Moloto. In October 2021 our website delivered 490 000 unique users and 925 000 page views, punching far above its weight as a news and information provider.

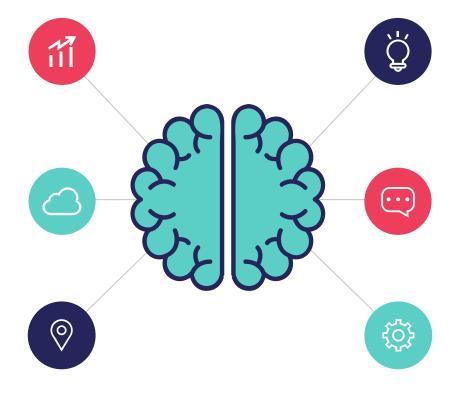

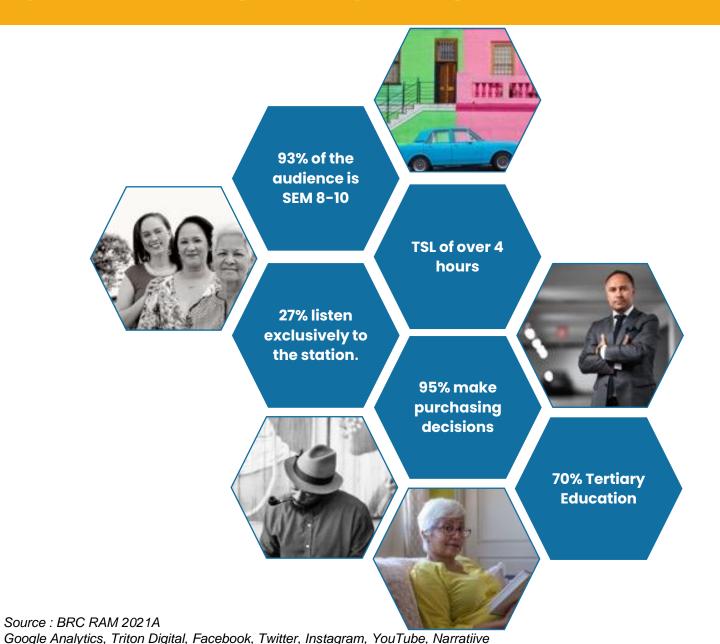
